Expectations of Pupils

- 1. Pupils at MTS are expected to be available for all Games sessions and competitive fixtures.
- 2. Pupils are also expected to adhere to school rules on the field of play at all times. Off-Games Procedure

If your child is unable to attend Games due to illness or injury, a parent must email <u>inewcombe@mtsn.org.uk</u> with a full explanation by midday at the latest, on the day of absence. We also ask that the pupil fills in an injury record form so that we can monitor the injury and assist where required. A link to the injury record form is below.

Despite a pupil being off-games, **they must attend their Games lesson at the start of the session to register**. In the majority of cases, pupils will be required to stay with their Games option and assist the coach/teacher where required. In exceptional circumstances, the pupil will be allowed to go to the library, but this is at the discretion of the teacher in charge. Pupils should not attend the library without prior authorisation.

School Physiotherapy

The School offers a physiotherapy service to support your son through any injury he might sustain. Should you wish to access this service there is cost of £100 per academic year, which covers all sessions and will go on the school bill. If your son has an initial consultation and does not require further support, there will be no charge. All sessions will take place either in games or the lunch hour on school site and are arranged via <u>Mr. Bruce</u>. Please complete the <u>Consent form</u> if you wish to receive this service should it be required.

Return2Play

As a part of our ongoing commitment to pupil welfare, we utilise the services of Return2Play a medical consultancy who are leading experts in Injury Management. Return2Play are the leading company in this field and our experiences with them to date have been overwhelmingly positive.

A special focus of Return2Play's service is the management of concussions. This includes, when required, providing parents unlimited access to the UK's leading doctors who have knowledge of the injury and critically, the protocols which need to be adhered to following the injury.

Additionally, Return2Play's injury management software enables the school to log and track the recovery of any injury that your child may experience. We firmly believe that the use of Return2Play will assist us in the continued provision of a gold standard level of care to your children.

The cost of Return2Play's comprehensive medical package is £30.00 per pupil for the academic year. Whilst it may be perceived that this will benefit those pupils who play more competitive school sport, Return2Play's data conclusively shows that injuries can occur at any time when performing physical activity and ultimately the service provided will protect the welfare of your child at all times. This service will be provided on an 'Opt Out' basis. Protective Equipment

Boys are expected to use the following safety equipment for the following sports;

- Rugby Gumshield for any contact situation.
- Hockey Gumshield and Shin pads for all gameplay situations.
- Cricket Relevant cricket equipment for batting.

Boys who lose or do not have their gumshield can get one from the school nurse during the week. The cost of which will be added to the pupils' school bill. Properly fitted gumshields are recommended for comfort but boil-in-the-bag gumshields are just as effective.

Footwear

Footwear is very important for growing boys. These are the following recommendations for footwear;

- PE Trainers Running shoes with laces are best.
- Hockey Astro turf shoes these can be football astro shoes but they need to have good grip on the sole for safety reasons.
- Rugby Boots Screw in studs are preferable over bladed boots.
- Cricket spikes (not compulsory).

Request for Absence Procedure

In <u>exceptional</u> circumstances, boys may be allowed to miss a Saturday fixture. In this case, a note will need to be sent to the Director of Sport in question with a MINIMUM of 2 notice. The request for absence will then be considered by the School staff and will be judged on an individual basis. The school, through the Director of Sport, reserves the right to not grant absence requests. Home Matches

Boys can arrive in their Games kit for matches; they will need to bring School Uniform for post-match teas. All boys are expected to play Rugby and Hockey in their shorts.

It is hoped that all parents will come to matches to support their son and the team he is representing. Tea, coffee and sandwiches will be available after all home matches for all spectators in the dining hall. We look forward to welcoming you.



Away Matches

Boys will need to travel in the expected dress code for that sport (MTS tracksuit for hockey, school uniform for rugby and whites with a blazer for cricket).
